Be sure to send in your box tops! They do add up and our goal is \$1,000 this school year!

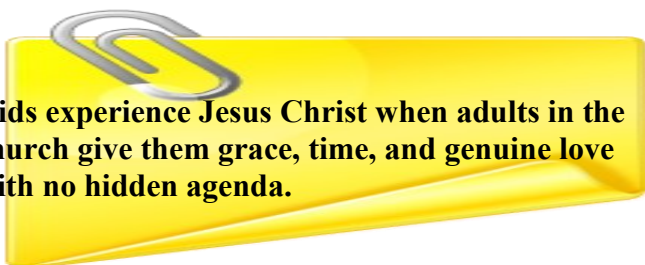
