8:30 – 10:30 a.m. – single students

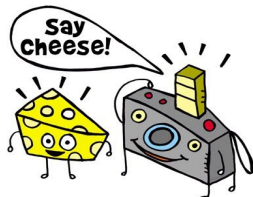
The background is “Timberloft” which can be viewed on our website
