And just like that... with a blink of the eye... the 2017-2018 school year has come to an end. We are traveling at warp speed as everything wraps up.

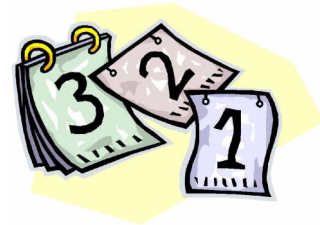
