Uniform reminders...

- Shoes must be flat, fully enclosed and must be FULLY black, gray, red, or white (or a combination of these) in color. **Uniform colors only!** No boots or sandals.

- Socks must be black, white, red and/ or gray in color. Black, white, red, or gray tights are acceptable for girls. Black, white, red, or gray leggings are acceptable and may be worn by girls in Kindergarten – 5th grades under their skirts, skorts, or shorts.
